FALSE PROPHETS

The people of this time had an intense desire for the fruits of their affluent society, expressed in the terms “wine” and “beer.” So if someone were to preach to them of greater affluence and prosperity, they would listen to him; and he would readily find acceptance among them. The implication is that Micah’s message of doom was unacceptable to those who were basking in the affluence of the eighth century.
